Entry

A maximum number of **325 competitors** will be allowed to register. Registration will be possible via [our website](#) only. An entry form will be available **December 1st**.

After filling in the digital entry form you will receive a confirmation email containing your registration number. If you do not, please [contact us](#). Please use the registration number in any entry correspondence.

Changes to your registration can be entered through our website until the registration closing date: **January 31** or whenever the maximum number of competitors is reached. During February any changes will require a Request For Changes form and manual approval.

FIG rules: all clubs **must** be members of a FIG member federation in good standing.

Payment

The entry fee is **€ 35** per competitor. Saturday evening a buffet will be available for those that register at the price of **€ 22**.

Entries are valid only after full **payment by bank transfer**, to the Aalsmeer Flower Cup bank account at the Rabobank in Aalsmeer. Bank account (IBAN): **NL15 RABO 0300 1504 74**, BIC/SWIFT code RABO NL 2U. Any bank transfer fees must be paid for.

No refund will be made for cancellations after February 28: the **full** amount must be paid nevertheless.

Judges

Clubs that enter competitors are required to send FIG licensed judges:

1-6 competitors: 1 judge

7-12 competitors: 2 judges

12+ competitors: 3 judges

The class II competition will allow (highest) national licenses as well.

Participation is at own risk. The insurance is the responsibility of the individual participants or their clubs. The Aalsmeer Flower Cup cannot be held responsible for accidents, theft or loss of money, goods or other property or persons.
