Rules

According to the [FIG Code of Points](#) valid as per 2017, including separate judging of Horizontal Displacement.

Finals: the top **eight** of each class/otherwise 2/3 of the start field of each class/possible wild card for a one athlete from the organizing club to start as ninth if not regularly qualified.

Registration

The nominative registration must be made online via the GymCity Open website. It is possible to register from the 1st of March 2019. All members of the delegation that attend the competition (athletes, coaches, judges) have to be registered.

Nominative registration must be done until the **15th of May 2019**.

Judges

Clubs that enter competitors are required to send FIG licensed judges:

1-6 competitors: 1 judge

7-12 competitors: 2 judges

12+ competitors: 3 judges

For a missing judge will be a fee of 25€ pro competitor to pay.

The FIG technical regulations foresee that all participating federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their delegation.
